

LRA distances itself from fake job vacancies on social media



Maseru, Thursday 5th, 2019: The Lesotho Revenue Authority (LRA) wishes to distance itself from fake jobs vacancy declaration doing the rounds in the social media. This fake advert is on the Government letterhead which LRA does not use under any circumstances.

Members of the public are advised to note that all vacant positions within the LRA are publicly announced/declared in local newspapers and the LRA website and such adverts always bear LRA symbols that include a logo and a tagline. There is a dedicated department at the LRA, Human Capital Management, that deals with issues of resourcing, which can be contacted at any given time for related matters.

Furthermore, members of the public are to note that a political party membership is never a requirement for whatever position that is being advertised by the LRA. Members of the public are therefore urged not to fall for this fake advert that is arguably intended to soil the good name of the Authority.
