

Revenue Services Lesotho Participates in Lesotho Regulators Forum

Maseru, Lesotho – 30 May 2025 – Revenue Services Lesotho (RSL) took part in the Lesotho Regulators Forum Meeting held on 27 May 2025 at Victory Hall. The one-day event aimed to reinvigorate the Forum, reinforcing its critical role as a collaborative platform for regulatory institutions across the country.

The Forum brings together Chief Executives from a diverse range of national regulatory bodies to foster inter-agency cooperation, share best practices, and develop cohesive strategies for navigating emerging regulatory challenges. Participating institutions include the Central Bank of Lesotho, Lesotho Communications Authority, Lesotho Mounted Police Service, Lesotho Electricity and Water Authority, Lesotho National Development Corporation, Ministry of Mining, Ministry of Trade and Industry, Financial Intelligence Unit, Land Administration Authority, Directorate on Corruption and Economic Offences, and Revenue Services Lesotho.

Key discussions during the meeting focused on strengthening the Forum's institutional framework. The meeting also emphasized the importance of shared regulatory intelligence, cross-sector collaboration, and proactive engagement to enhance public service delivery and contribute to Lesotho's economic resilience.
