

RSL–LNDC Joint Engagement for the Manufacturing Sector on “Tax Compliance”

The Revenue Services Lesotho (RSL), in partnership with the Lesotho National Development Corporation (LNDC), hosted a joint engagement session for the manufacturing sector under the theme “Tax Compliance”.

Speaking at the event, the RSL Commissioner General, Mrs. Mathabo Mokoko, reaffirmed the organisation’s commitment to supporting the manufacturing industry, recognising it as a key driver of Lesotho’s economic growth.

“RSL will do everything possible to support manufacturing because it is an important player in the economy. Our primary interest is to ensure that manufacturing businesses grow, the economy grows, and livelihoods improve,” said Mrs. Mokoko.

She further encouraged the sector to engage freely with RSL, reminding participants that all RSL services are offered free of charge.

The engagement covered key topics, including:

- Tax compliance requirements and services offered to the manufacturing sector
- The audit process
- Refunds process and digitalisation
- Customs procedures and export incentives
- Market opportunities for manufacturers

This initiative forms part of the Mphahlolle Campaign, an RSL-led awareness drive aimed at informing businesses and the public about RSL’s initiatives, services, and the importance of compliance in driving national development.
