

REVENUE SERVICES LESOTHO OFFICIALLY ACTIVATES THE 2026 FILING SEASON

Maseru, Lesotho – 08 May 2026 - Revenue Services Lesotho (RSL) today officially activated the 2026 Filing Season and calls upon all taxpayers across the country to submit their Income Tax Returns and settle any taxes due on or before 30 June 2026.

The filing season commenced on 1 April 2026 and serves as an important period for individuals and businesses to fulfil their tax obligations in accordance with the laws of Lesotho.

Speaking during the activation, RSL Deputy Commissioner-Digital Services Mr Tsepo Raletoane emphasised that tax compliance remains a shared responsibility that contributes directly to national development. Taxes collected by Government support the delivery of essential public services including healthcare, education, infrastructure development, security, and social protection programmes.

RSL therefore encourages all taxpayers to file accurate returns and make payments on time in order to avoid penalties, additional taxes, and other unnecessary inconveniences.

The Service further highlighted the importance of voluntary compliance in building a fair and sustainable tax system where every taxpayer contributes their fair share towards the development of the country.
