RSL COMPLETES DRIVE TO PLANT 22 000 TREES

RSL in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment and Forestry continued a drive to plant twenty-two thousand (22 000) trees across the country to contribute in environmental conservation. The 22 000 trees were planted in areas such as Ha Leutsoa, Ha Makotoko, Mahloenyeng, Ha Ntsane, Masapong Primary School, Metolong Primary School, Mafika Li Siu Primary School, Matikoe High School, Toloane Primary School, Machache Primary School, Setebing Primary School, Metsoarong Primary School, National University of Lesotho (NUL), Lesotho Defence Force (LDF), Ha Pita, and Ha Lechesa. In 2023, RSL successfully planted 20,000 trees. Building on this momentum, RSL planted an additional 21,000 trees in 2024. This annual increment of 1,000 trees reflects RSL's dedication to expanding its environmental impact year by year. This initiative will not only support environmental conservation but also demonstrate RSL's dedication to sustainable development and community engagement.



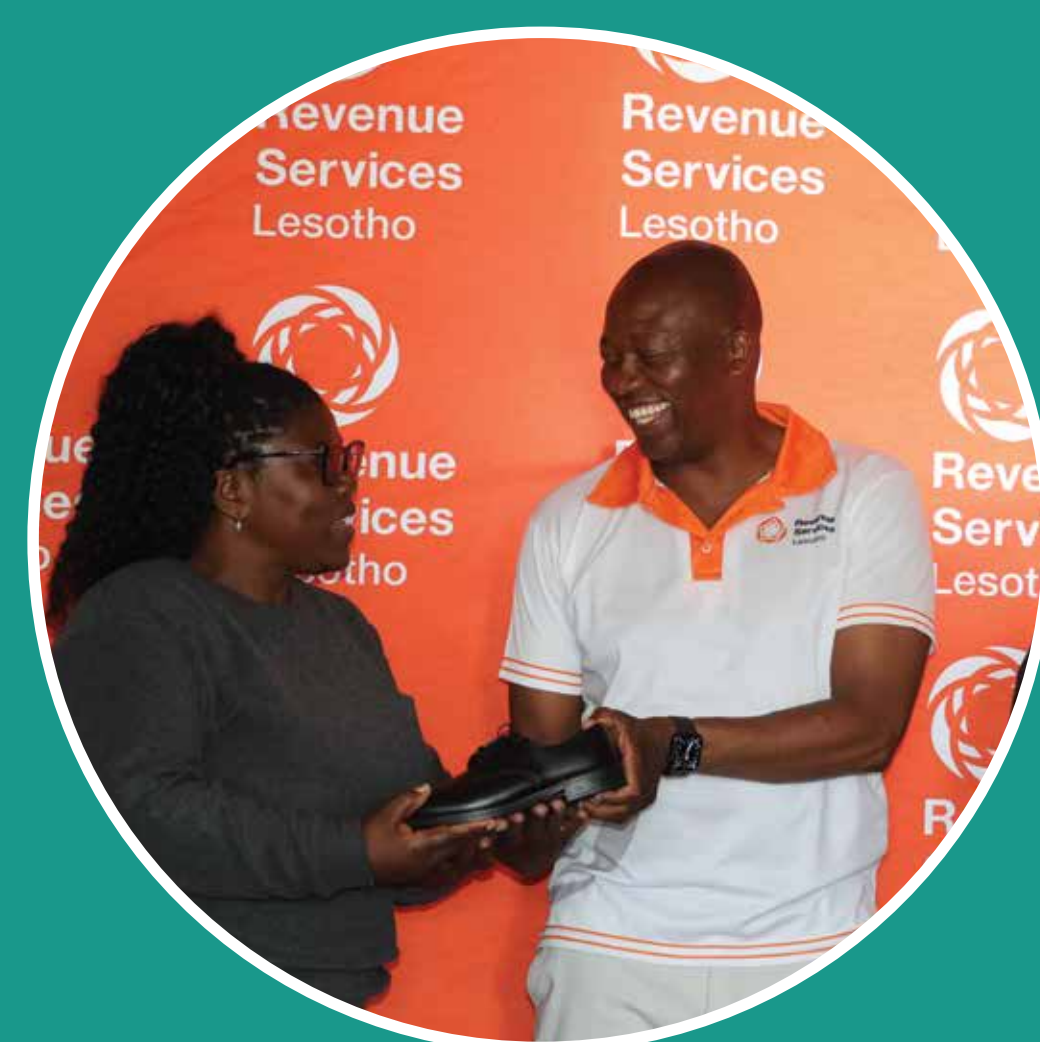
CELEBRATING WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY THE RSL WAY
